INTRODUCING

# THE PETERMAN

Petersfield; an area of rich history; Reform, Challenge and Protest. Everyone has heard the stories of the Suffragettes and the reform of the Corn Laws, but here we tell another - Starting here at Forty-Seven.

Starting with; The Peterloo massacre of 1819, chaired by Henry Hunt wrote: Nothing but ruin and starvation stare one in the face [in the streets of Manchester and the surrounding towns], the state of this district is truly dreadful, and I believe nothing but the greatest exertions can prevent an insurrection. Oh, that you in London were prepared for it.

Later; the fight of the Suffragettes, and here, on Peter Street in 1905, at a political meeting saw Christabel Pankhurst and millworker, Annie Kenney, disrupted speeches by Winston Churchill, asking where Churchill stood with regards to women's political rights. At a time when political meetings were only attended by men, the audience were outraged, and when the women unfurled a "Votes for Women" banner they were both arrested for a technical assault on a policeman. When Pankhurst and Kenney appeared in court they both refused to pay the fine imposed, preferring to go to prison to gain publicity for their cause.

But a saga standing between these two great stories is one untold, one that has been hidden, a gossip only ever whispered. The story of "The Peterman".

**UNTOLD;** This tale starts here on Peter Street, where here Forty-Seven in 1868 built was as a shipping warehouse surrounded by cotton mills and factories churning out the smog of the city. The Manchester Evening News published its first newspaper and five notorious Peterman saw this as a way to make a headline or two, make a name of themselves on Peter Street and hopefully avoid an imprisonment at Strangways or even worse, a hanging at this new prison that also opened this year.

As leading mobsters of their towns they knew each other from the shadows and one cold, wet November evening met here at Forty-Seven. In the lower ground of this former-warehouse to discuss trade secrets, discuss plans and share wealth, although, it is believed, they mainly acted alone. To this day what they planned was never discovered. Many say that the plan failed, some say that they were the orchestrators of many of the great robberies in London and retried North to never be caught.

## NAUGHTY NICK OF NORTHENDEN



Naughty Nick of Northenden was always in a tall hat that cast a shadow over his face. They say that he could hear people approaching from over a mile away. Many knew what he did but as a master of his game but many turned a blind-eye to his naughty tricks as they knew Nick could open any lock at any time of night.





## WISE WILLAIM OF WITHINGTON

A young good-looking chap with plenty of charm. Willaim got his name as he was always sensible. Never caught. For every safe bust open he gave the contents to the workers in the cotton mills and warehouses around the Petersfield area. This way you could always have an alibi; somebody to cover his tracks, somebody tell a different story that completely baffled and confused the police.



## DIAMOND DAN OF DIDSBURY



Diamond Dan A.K.A Drunk Dan.

He exchanged diamonds for liquor. He stole diamonds and pearls and traded them with the master distiller of Didsbury Gin. He stumbled with blurry eyes from one safe job to another. Although he was successful he was also caught many times by the police and chucked in to the cells overnight.

He was left to sober up for the following morning where his pockets lay empty time and time again justifying no charges.





## SPARKLING SALLY OF STOCKPORT

Sparkling Sally was a proud woman. She was a family woman with a large family from Stockport. She wore heart and her possessions on her sleeve some might say. Sally sparkled from head-to-toe with every button hole showing off a different diamond stolen from safes across the Greater Manchester area.

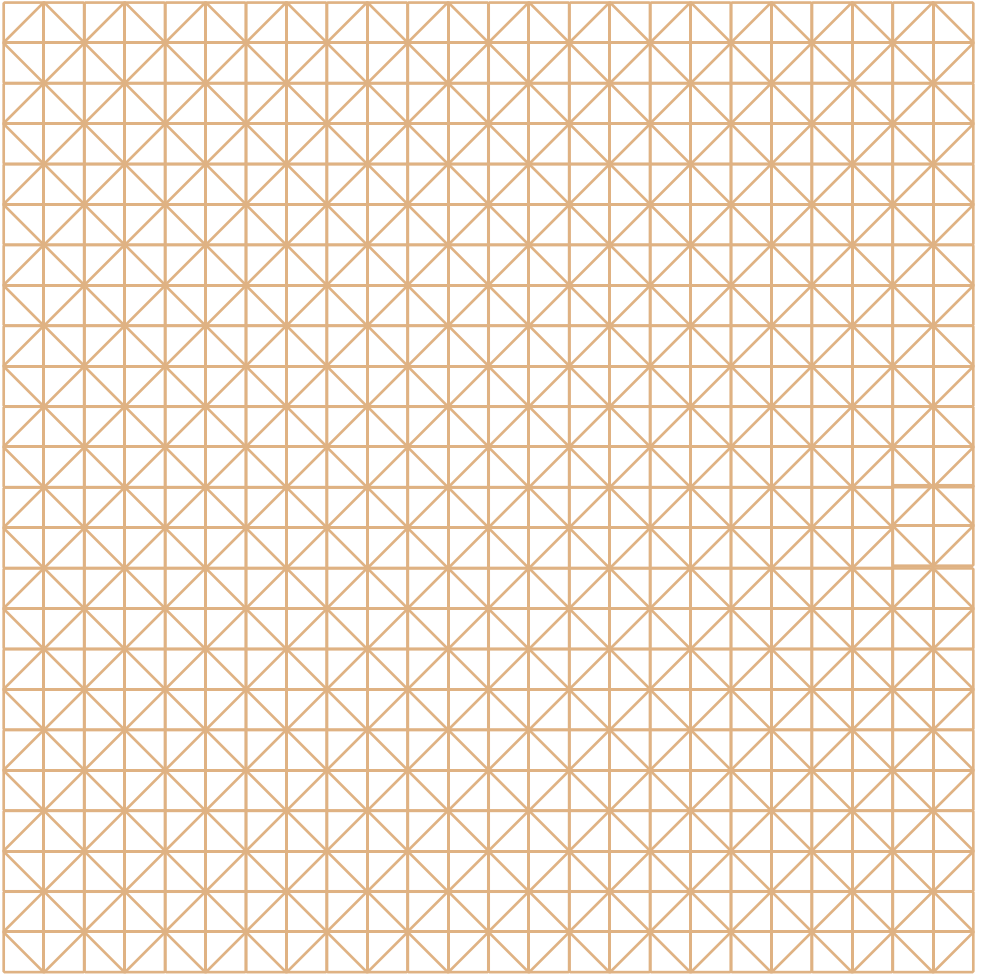


## FEARLESS FREDDIE OF FALLOWFIELD
